According to UDC bylaws, the nominations begins August 1st and ends on August 31st during the even years. The nominated candidates for UDC officers seats will be announced on November 16, 2024 2:10pm at the Deaf Center Gym during the UDC Summit Conference.

The nominated candidates with the most votes will fill each of the four executive officers seats; president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer. The UDC members will have a chance to interview each nominated candidates. This is the democratic process and your votes are crucial.

Winterizing Your Towable RV?

Winterizing your towable RV, such as a travel trailer or 5th-wheel, and/or motor home is a bittersweet affair. On one hand you have to do it so your precious baby will survive the cold weather ahead. On the other hand, it means the end of the camping season. By the way, there is nothing sweet about it. It's all bitter. Regardless, it's one of those jobs you have to do.

The most important step to winterize your camper is to make sure the water in the pipes do not freeze. To do this, you remove as much water as possible from the pipes, and then add antifreeze so any remaining water does not freeze. Here's a check list to help you prevent water freezing in your RV:

1. Make sure the grey and black tanks are empty. (This is a good time to clean the black tank with a "wand" attachment at the end of the hose.
2. Drain the fresh water tank. This is crucial!
3. Drain all the water at the low point drains.
4. Drain the hot water heater and leave the drain plug open. This is a good time to clean the inside of the tank with wand attachment at the end of the hose.
5. Remove all water from your water heater and drains by blowing compressed air into the city water inlet. (Use caution when doing this). You can skip this step if you're not comfortable with blowing compressed air in your water lines or tanks.
6. If you have a water filter, remove it and install a filter bypass. This will prevent antifreeze from ruining the water filter.
7. Add RV antifreeze - never use auto antifreeze - to your RV. Use water pump or manual pump to push the antifreeze through the waterlines.
